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"Rapid review of literature on Measures used to Assess Patient Involvement Interventions in Denmark"

The MAPII-study is a rapid review of literature conducted to deliver timely and actionable evidence to stakeholders on Measures used to Assess Patient Involvement Interventions in Denmark. The study is ongoing. The methods of rapid review will be presented, and the adaptations made in the research process will be compared to the procedures of conducting a systematic review. Strengths and limitations of the rapid review will be discussed as well as the potential for future research.
